# Answer Sheet

- 1) **c.** *Matthew 27:29, "They braided a crown of thorns and put it on his head." See also Mark 15:17, John 19:2.*
- 2) **b.** *Mark 15:21, "They compelled one passing by... Simon of Cyrene... to go with them, that he might bear his cross." See also Matthew 27:32, Luke 23:26.*
- 3) **a.** *Matthew 27:37, "They set up over his head the accusation against him written, 'THIS IS JESUS, THE KING OF THE JEWS.'" See also Mark 15:26, Luke 23:38. (John 19:19 does not specify position of inscription on cross)*
- 4) **d.** *Mark 15:27, "With him they crucified two robbers." See also Matthew 27:38, Luke 23:39-40, John 19:18.*
- 5) **c.** *Luke 23:45, "The veil of the temple was torn in two." See also Matthew 27:51, Mark 15:38. Some versions use the word "veil," while others use the word "curtain."*
- 6) **b.** *John 19:33-34 "When they came to Jesus, and saw that he was already dead, they didn't break his legs. However one of the soldiers pierced his side with a spear." The Gospel of John is the only one of the four Gospels that records this.*
- 7) **d.** *John 19:38, "Joseph of Arimathaea...asked of Pilate that he might take away Jesus' body." See also Matthew 27:58, Mark 15:43, Luke 23:51-52.*
- 8) **a.** *Matthew 28:1, "Now after the Sabbath, as it began to dawn on the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to see the tomb." See also Mark 16:1-2, Luke 24:1, John 20:1*
- 9) **b.** *Luke 24:2, "They found the stone rolled away from the tomb." See also Matthew 28:2, Mark 16:4, John 20:1*
- 10) **c.** *John 20:15, "She, supposing him to be the gardener, said to him..."*
- 11) **b.** *Matthew 27:52-53, "Many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised; and coming out of the tombs after his resurrection, they entered into the holy city and appeared to many." The Gospel of Matthew is the only one of the four Gospels that records this.*
